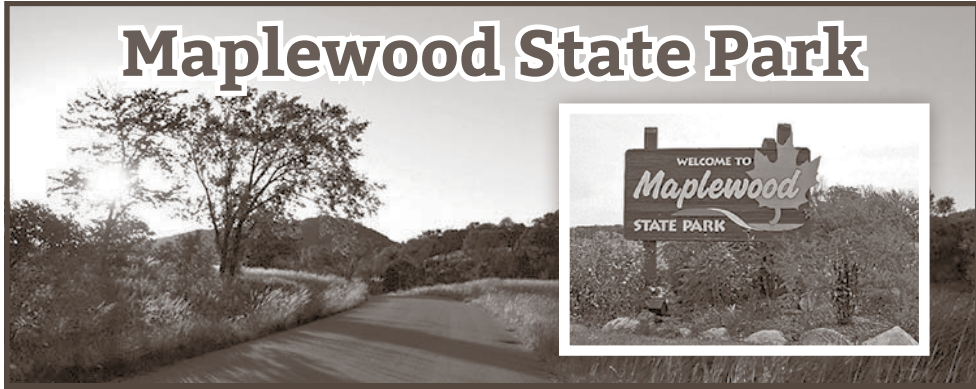

THEY DID WHAT?

Genetically modified plants have been available for years for farmers, but now, they are fooling around with our flowers and vegetables. Norfolk Healthy Produce has introduced a dark purple intermediate cherry tomato. Norfolk Plant Science crossed a snapdragon with a regular cherry tomato to get this new combination. It should be good for you as it has those dark blue anthocyanins, the healthy antioxidants found in blueberries, blackberries and eggplant. But how does it taste? If it is like other cherry tomatoes, leave one in the garden and you have them forever. In polite terms, they re-seed readily.

Now for a really scary GMO cross. Light Bros, and the name should give you a clue, has crossed a petunia with a naturally occurring luminescent mushroom. Why would a mushroom need to glow in the dark? How did they make this cross and, more importantly, why?

The "Firefly" petunia is genetically engineered to glow in the dark. It looks like any ordinary petunia and has the same cultivation requirements, however—it emits a soft green glow after sunset. The blossoms glow the most, but that diminishes as the flower matures. As long as the plant is healthy and continues to grow it will continue to glow.

Can you just imagine what a hungry deer will think when his midnight snack is glowing? Might plant them just to spook the snackers. If you are into this sort of thing, you can pre-order them at www.light.bio.

Another spooky thing is happening in wildflowers. As the worldwide populations of pollinating insects continue to decline, researchers in France have documented wildflowers have begun to self-fertilize. The phenomenon, termed "selfing syndrome". The plants using this method of reproducing have less nectar which further threatens the pollinators.

Scientists at the National Centre for Scientific Research (CNRS) in France and

the University of Montpellier compared seeds from field pansies (*Viola arvensis*) growing near Paris this year to some grown from the same area between 1992 and 2001. Today's flowers are 10% smaller and produce 20% less nectar. Even worse, they are less visited than their ancestors.

Changes in plant pollinator interactions have happened before but not this rapidly. Selfing syndrome is an evolutionary transition that most scientists consider irreversible and noted that higher extinction rates usually follow those developments. If you want to plow through more scientific information, there is a research paper published in the journal *New Phytologist* at <http://bit.ly/3SK2t2>.

Now for more normal gardening information. The American Iris society has given it's "Iris of The Year" to "Don't Doubt Dalton". She is a tall, bearded iris developed by hybridizer Tom Burseen of Grand Prairie Texas. She is described as---an early to late bloomer with standards of pure white with red-purple random spattering. The center of the flower, the arms are washed gold. The falls are pure white with random dark purple splatters. The poppy orange beards with tattered white and feathered white horns and gold stems. It is both a "color breaker" referring to the splatters and a 'space ager'. The latter referring to a horn, spoon or flounce appendage at the end of the beard. Apparently, this is uncommon for a bearded iris. Having both characteristics is highly unusual. The picture shows a narrow curled up petal at the end of the beard. This iris has been available since 2015. It was named for a friend's grandson who rides bulls. Kid must be named Dalton. We should be seeing our own iris very early this year. Sounds like a very hot, dry summer.

Water: Water is off in the campground for the season until May 12, 2023. Water is available year-round at the park office.
Drinking Water: Water is off in the campground for the season until May 12, 2023. Water is available year-round at the park office.
Bathroom Facilities: Trail center restrooms are open year-round! Modern restroom facilities in the campground are closed for season until May 12, 2023. Vault toilets in the park are open year-round. Facilities are wheelchair accessible.
Showers: Showers are closed for season until May 12, 2023. Showers are wheelchair accessible.
DUMP STATION: NONE
CAMPGROUNDS: Cart-in campground is open year-round. Camper Cabins and Yurts are open year-round, but just weekends between Nov. 1 and March 31. The group camp is closed until May 5, 2023. Canoe sites are closed for season until April 28, 2023.
ELECTRIC SITES: One RV electric site is available after October 3 by calling the park. All camper cabins have electricity.
SPECIAL NOTES FOR RV CAMPERS: There is no RV camping in park in summer. Private RV campground is nearby.
Trail Notes: The park has 11 miles of hiking trail, 5.5 miles of surfaced bike trail and 2.2 miles of mountain bike trails. In winter, park maintains 7 miles of groomed, easy to intermediate, level cross-country ski trails and 1-2 miles of snowshoe trails.
Season Rentals: Bicycle, rowboat, canoe, kayak, paddleboat, and stand up paddleboard rental is closed for season. Winter rentals (cross-country skis and snowshoes) are available when conditions allow.
Naturalist Programs and Park Tours: Check the park Events Calendar on the park web page for more information on programs.
Buildings and Attractions: Historic Lodge and Dining Hall are available to rent year round and can be reserved by calling the park. Discounted winter rates apply from November 1 to April 30. Molly Stark Picnic Shelter is closed for season.

Nestled in the transition zone between prairie and hardwood forest, Glendalough offers a true respite from civilization. Crystal clear Annie Battle Lake is a 335-acre, non-motorized "Heritage Fishery" that provides a tranquil fishing experience second to none. Special regulations sustain a steady supply of large sunfish, crappie, and the occasional walleye for the frying pan, and large bass for the camera. Near the pristine shores of this lake are a cart-in campground and canoe-in campsites, all free from the traffic and noise of traditional drive-in camping. Annie can also be the starting point for an exploration of the park by canoe or kayak on the connecting creeks. The restored historic Glendalough Lodge on the north side of the lake details the park's history as a private retreat and game farm for the Minneapolis Tribune.

Numerous hiking trails, including two interpretive trails, meander along five lakes, through rich woods and blooming prairies. Wildlife abounds year-round, and there are many observation decks along the trails. Trails are groomed in winter for skiing and snowshoeing. Picnicking and swimming is available on two sandy lakes.

Migrating monarchs should be highly visible along the Prairie Hill Trail from mid-August through Labor Day. Vehicle permits are required and can be purchased at the park. For more information, call the park at 218-864-0110.
