


Every week, for the last 24 years, I have written a gardening article for several local newspapers. At age 89, I feel it's time to retire while I still have a few working

IS FARMING TO BLAME?

Can you believe that some climatologists are blaming the corn farmers for some of our bad weather? Corn, like all plants and many mammals, sweats - only in plants it is called transpiration. An acre of corn can put up to 3,000-4,000 gallons of water into the air every day. Richard Raddatz, a climatologist at the University of Winnipeg has studied the change of the Canadian prairies from grassland to cropland. He feels that there is a growing body of research indicating that contemporary crops change the way water, heat and energy interact with the atmosphere. By transpiring more heavily than the native grasses that they replaced in relatively short periods, crops can generate air movements that can lead to storms during the season when water is cycled through the atmosphere. One study, done by Okland climatologist Jeff Basara, traced a link between corn evapotranspiration and a F2 tornado that hit Benson Minnesota in June of 2001. He said, "there was going to be bad weather that day, but evaporation added enough moisture to the atmosphere to turn it from a day of localized severe weather to a day that really was a headline maker." Wayne Hallock, whose family has farmed in Dakota county since 1912, thinks that corn may affect the weather. He now has 34,000 plants per acre. In the 70's, he and his father used to plant only 16,000 per acre. He found that corn and soybeans, some of which are only 10 inches apart instead of 30 in earlier years, are often wet with dew until noon on dry days. Another

climatologist, David Changon of Northern

Illinois University, feels the forty-year trend toward higher dew points during recent heat waves is due to changes in farming practices. His proof is that since 1950 crops had replaced thousands of square acres of pastureland. Even more significant, he felt, was the shift in corn planting from 40-inch rows to 30-inch rows thus putting more water into the air. Not everyone agrees. Here at home, one of our climatologists, Pete Boulay, points out that in the Twin Cities the average dew point in 3 of the last 4 summers has been below average and much of the corn production parts of the state are now in the second season of dry conditions. Of course, some of the dew points were gathered at the airport where it is heavily paved. Dew points at the University are higher probably because it is irrigated.

Information is from an article in the Minneapolis Star Tribune, now called the Minnesota Tribune.

This is a recycled article from the early 2000's, but still very interesting. The theory hasn't been disproved and does sound pretty logical. That being said, don't go after your local farmer with a pitchfork. There is enough blame to go around. This area is still short of normal moisture as anyone who lives by a lake can tell you. Summer is just beginning. We could be hip deep in water by August. It's Minnesota after all - where the weather can be dry and 30 degrees in the morning, 60 degrees by lunch, and a roaring thunderstorm by 6 o'clock. But we love it.







Chipotle Grilled Chicken Lettuce Wraps

For the Chicken + Marinade

- 2 tablespoons olive oil
- 2 tablespoons water
- 3-4 chipotle peppers in adobo
- 1 teaspoon garlic powder
- 1 teaspoon ground cumin
- 1/2 teaspoon dried oregano
- 1/2 teaspoon black pepper
- 10 boneless skinless chicken thighs cut in half

For the Lettuce Wraps:

- 1 head butter lettuce
- 2 mangos cut into thin strips
- 1/2 red onion thinly sliced
- 1/2 orange bell pepper thinly sliced
- 2 avocados thinly sliced

fresh mint

fresh cilantro 1-2 limes, juiced

kosher salt and freshly cracked black pepper to taste

- 1. Put the ingredients for the marinade in a food processor or blender and blend until smooth. Coat the chicken thighs in the marinade and refrigerate for 1-4 hours.
- 2. After marinating, Heat an indoor or outdoor grill to about 400 degrees F (medium high heat). Place the chicken onto the grill and grill 5 to 6 minutes per side, until the chicken is cooked. Remove the chicken from the grill and let rest for 10 minutes.
- 3. Meanwhile clean the butter lettuce and separate it into cups.
- 4. Combine the mango, red onion, bell pepper, avocado, mint, cilantro and lime juice in a bowl and toss to combine. Season with salt and pepper.
- 5. Assemble the lettuce cups with a piece of chicken, a few tablespoons of the topping and serve with extra limes if needed.

Grilled Pork Chops

- 4 bone-in pork loin chops 1 1/4- to 1 1/2-inches thick
- 1 small lemon
- 1 tablespoon minced fresh rosemary
- 1 teaspoon kosher salt
- 1 teaspoon ground black pepper
- 3 cloves minced garlic about 1 tablespoon
- Chopped fresh parsley basil, or herbs of choice (optional for serving)
- 1. Pat the pork chops dry on both sides.
- 2. Zest the lemon into a small bowl. Add the rosemary, salt, pepper, and garlic. With your fingers, rub to combine. It should smell very fragrant. Slice the lemon into wedges and reserve for serving.
- 3. Rub the lemon/rosemary mixture all over the outsides of the pork. Cover the pork chops and let sit for 1 hour at room temperature or refrigerate up to overnight. Let come to room temperature prior to grilling.
- 4. When ready to grill, heat a grill or grill pan over medium-high heat. If you are using a grill pan, you will need to cook the pork in batches (if the chops are too crowded in the pan, the chops will steam and not sear properly). Place the pork chops on the grill. Cook on the first side for 5 minutes, until the pork chop easily releases from the grill.
- 5. Flip and cook on the other side for another 4 to 8 minutes (the cooking time will vary based upon your grill temperature and the thickness of your pork), until the pork reaches 135°F on an instant read thermometer (it will continue to cook and the temperature will keep rising as it rests). When the pork chops are done, they will feel just firm to the touch, the juices will run slightly pink, and the meat will look rosy in the center. Place on a platter, cover with aluminum foil, and let rest 10 minutes.
- 6. Once the pork chops have rested, serve hot with reserved lemon wedges.

Grilled Steak Salad

Dressing

- 4 garlic cloves, peeled, smashed
- 1/2 cup extra-virgin olive oil
- 1/3 cup balsamic vinegar
- 1/2 tsp. granulated sugar
- 1/2 tsp. kosher salt
- 1/4 tsp. freshly ground black pepper

Salad

- 1 medium red onion, cut into 1/2" slices
- 1 tsp. extra-virgin olive oil
- Kosher salt
- 1 1/4 lb. boneless ribeye steak
- Freshly ground black pepper
- 5 oz. baby arugula and/or baby spinach
- 1 avocado, pitted, sliced
- 1 cup cherry tomatoes, halved
- 4 oz. blue cheese, crumbled Torn fresh basil leaves, for serving
- 1. In a small saucepan over medium heat, cook garlic and oil, stirring occasionally, until garlic is fragrant and softened, 5 to 7 minutes. Let cool
- 2. Transfer garlic and oil to a blender. Add vinegar, granulated sugar, salt, and pepper and blend until very smooth. Pour into a jar and refrigerate until ready
- 3. Make Ahead: Dressing can be made 1 week ahead. Keep refrigerated.


- $1. \ Prepare \ a \ grill \ for \ medium-high \ heat; \ preheat \ 5 \ minutes \ and \ clean \ grates.$ Drizzle onion with oil; season with salt. Generously season steak with salt and
- 2. Grill onions, turning once, until char marks appear, 2 to 3 minutes per side, and grill steak, turning occasionally, until an instant-read thermometer inserted into thickest part registers 130° for medium-rare, about 6 minutes per side. Transfer onions and steak to a cutting board. Let cool slightly. Thinly slice steak against the grain.
- 3. On a large platter, arrange arugula. Top with steak, onions, avocado, tomatoes, blue cheese, and basil. Drizzle with dressing before serving.
